



Interested in Scholarship Aid?

Scholarship period effective Oct. 1, 2012 through June 1st, 2013

There are various Tuition Scholarships available to Members of RHID each dance year. Full Family Tuition Scholarship, 75% Off One Student Tuition, 50% off One Student Tuition, Costume and Shoe Assistance Program. Those who wish to be considered for aid must agree to the terms of the scholarship notes and submit a 1-page essay stating How Irish Dance Influences the Dancer's life. Please note that the scholarship review process may take as long as 3-4 weeks, and application does not guarantee award of the scholarship. *The names of dancers awarded scholarship aid will remain confidential.* Parents can volunteer their time with tasks at the studio in exchange for tuition discounts, please see Miss Stephanie directly.

Scholarship Notes:

- Scholarship students are required to maintain near perfect attendance for the minimum recommended classes at the student's level, follow the rules of the school, and commit to multiple performances in RHID events. Failure to meet the commitments will result in loss of scholarship and repayment of scholarship funds.
- Scholarships are for Tuition only. Students receiving scholarship aid will be required to purchase dress code appropriate attire, including all dance shoes and pay school costume. Please note if you are applying for the costume and shoe assistance program.

Scholarship Aid Available:

Full Family Tuition: Tuition assistance good for the entire family's tuition, up to 5 dancers.

75% off Dancer Tuition: Tuition assistance is good for one child, additional children still get the sibling discount rate.

50% off Dancer Tuition: Tuition assistance of half off the full price rate for one child, siblings still get discounted rate.

Costume and Shoe Assistance: RHID will help your dancer get shoes and costumes at a discounted rate.

Students can only be considered for scholarship aid after an application and all required documents are submitted. RHID scholarships are in effect from October 1 through June 1 of the following year, Tuition Assistance is not available for the Summer Sessions.

All students are responsible to pay for the Annual Registration (\$30) and their 1st month's tuition.
